

A MAJESTIC RUSSIAN LANDMARK

With its world-famous ballet and opera, and the White Nights Festival in the summer, St Petersburg is a year-round destination. Spectacular monuments, sculptures and bridges line the Neva River in this magnificent city, often called the 'Venice of the North'. Many of St Petersburg's main attractions, including the Hermitage Museum and the Mariinsky Theatre, are within walking distance of Hotel Astoria. With its authentic Art Nouveau architecture, the hotel blends glamorous Russian elegance with modern facilities. Bedrooms, many with views of St Isaac's Square and Cathedral, are a stylish mix of antiques and contemporary design. 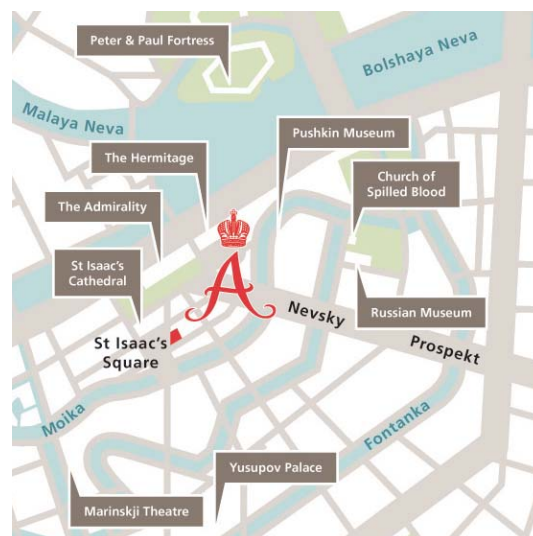

Location

The hotel is centrally located next to the landmark St Isaac's Cathedral and is an ideal base from which to explore this beautiful city. St Petersburg was founded in 1703 by Peter the Great and built on the River Neva delta on the Gulf of Finland, interspersed with picturesque canals. Many of the main attractions are within walking distance of the hotel, such as the famous Hermitage Museum and some of the 150 palaces, churches and gardens. In early summer the "White Nights" are a popular attraction, whilst the scenic winter period offers the renowned Mariinsky ballet and opera.



Directions

By Air

The main airport is a 30-minute drive from the hotel and is well-served by international flights to key cities, including daily three-hour direct flights from London.

By Car

The main railway station is a short drive from the hotel. St Petersburg is 3.5 hours from Moscow by the Sapsan train, and 3.5 hours from Helsinki by the new Allegro trains.
